We have 900 digital photographs of York that need identifying and dating (even approximate dates are fine!) before we can put them on

our new [Explore York Images](#) website. Some of them are easy, some of them are not so easy – so it will be a test of how well you know York.

In some cases there will be some information on the image – for example, we may have the name of the building but not the street. In other cases there will be no identifying information on the image at all.

We will be releasing 100 new images a week (on Wednesdays) over the next 9 weeks – starting 29 April.
